How do I apply?

Eligibility requirements*

Active duty service members must:

- Be within 180 days of the end-of service date;
- Secure command approval to participate;
- Submit proof of honorable service status.

Veterans must:

- Submit a DD-214 (proof of veteran status)

Admissions prerequisites

All learning paths (SCA, CAD, CSO):

- A valid Pearson Vue IT Specialist (ITS) certification aligned to the applicant's selected learning path. *Many applicants earn their certification during the MSSA application process!* [Learn more.](#)

- 2+ years' experience in networking, server operating systems, and cybersecurity.
